- (i) Represented the country in the International championships/events either in World Cup (Junior/Senior Category)/World Championships (Junior/Senior Category)/Asian Games (Senior Category)/Commonwealth Games (Senior Category).
OR
- (ii) Obtained atleast 3rd position in Commonwealth Championships (Junior/Senior Category)/Asian Championships/Asia Cup (Junior/Senior Category)/South Asian Federations (SAF) Games (Senior Category)/USIC (World Railways) Championships (Senior Category).
OR
- (iii) Obtained atleast 3rd position in Senior/Youth/Junior National Championships.
OR
- (iv) Obtained atleast 3rd position in National Games organized under aegis of Indian Olympic Association.
OR
- (v) Obtained atleast 3rd position in All India Inter University Championship organized under the aegis of Association of Indian Universities.
OR
- (vi) Obtained 1st position in Federation Cup Championships (Senior Category).

4.2 Sportspersons applying for the posts in PB-1 ` .5200-20200 + Grade Pay ` .1800 (erstwhile Gr.'D' posts) against any of the Games as mentioned in the above table should have:

- (i) Represented the country in Championship in either Commonwealth Championships (Junior/Senior Category)/Asian Championships/Asia Cup (Junior/Senior Category)/South Asian Federations (SAF) Games (Senior Category)/USIC (World Railways) Championships (Senior Category).
OR
- (ii) Obtained atleast 3rd position in Federation Cup Championships (Senior Category).
OR
- (iii) Represented a State of equivalent Unit, except in Marathon and Cross Country, in Senior/Youth/Junior National Championships.
OR
- (iv) Obtained atleast 3rd position in Senior State Championships for all units and Districts of the state.

Note:

- (a) **In team sports**, only sportspersons who have actually played the sport in field, will only be eligible. Therefore, a sportspersons who represents as member of a team in any recognized sports events/championship but has actually not played in the field, will not be considered for recruitment against sports quota. Accordingly, the candidate has to produce a certificate for actual participation in field for his/her recognised sports achievements along with the application.
- (b) **In Athletics**, medal winning performance in National Inter State Senior Athletics Championships, will also be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay ₹.1900 in PB-1 ₹.5200-20200.
- (c) **In Chess**, following sports achievements will also be considered for recruitment in different Grade pay and Pay Bands listed below:

Only the current Annual All India Ranking will be considered for these purposes. Ranking in Mixed-Doubles shall not be considered.

- (e) **In Cricket at International level**, representation of Main Indian Seniors Team in a Test Match or in a Limited Overs One Day International Match or in a Twenty-20 Overs Match, are eligible for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay ₹.1900/2000 in PB-1 ₹.5200-20200.
- (f) **In Cricket at National Level**, following sports achievements in 4Days/One Day Limited Overs/Twenty-20 Overs (Men) Championships (except Vizzy Trophy); organized under the aegis of BCCI, will also be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay ₹.1800 or 1900 in Pay Band ₹.5200-20200:

- (g) **In Golf**, for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay ` .1800 in PB-1 ` .5200-20200; sportspersons having Indian Golf Union ranking up to 100, subject to single handicap i.e. less than 10 (in order of Merit/Amateur Merit list) will also be eligible for recruitment. Only the current Annual All India Ranking will be considered for these purposes.
- (h) **In Hockey**, for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay ` . 1800/- in Pay band ` . 5200-20200, participation in International Tournaments of four or more nations will be considered. 5. PERIOD OF RECKONING SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS:

For recruitment against sports quota, recognised sports achievements should be in the current and/or immediate previous two financial years and sports persons should be an active player. Therefore, the sports achievements on or after 01.04.2013 are only considered.

 - (c) Candidates must write their name, full address in the space provided in the Indian Postal Order.
 - (d) The examination fee is not refundable/transferable/adjustable under any circumstances.

8. HOW TO APPLY:

- 8.3 The application should be filled by the candidate in his/her own handwriting and signed.

10. RECRUITMENT PROCESS:

The recruitment will be based on trials, assessment of sports achievements and general intelligence/personality etc. The candidates **who are found fit** in trials only will be considered for next stage.

11. MEDICAL EXAMINATION:

The Candidates recommended for appointment will have to pass the requisite medical fitness test(s) conducted by the Railway Administration to ensure that the candidates are Medically FIT to carry out the duties connected with the post. Only those candidates who are Medically FIT would be empanelled for appointment.
